	Primary Road & Priority	Improvement
1.	U.S. 15/29 & Rt. 215 Intersection	Rt. 215 Relocation/construction from U.S. 15/29 to Vint Hill. Design work for the ultimate interchange at Route 215 and Route15/29.
2.	Route 28 (from U.S. 15/29 to PWC)	Spot safety & intersection improvements
3.	U.S. 15/29 & Rt. 17/Opal Interchange	Flyover
4.	U.S 15/29 & East Shirley Avenue Intersection	 Initiate future interchange design study for south entrance/exit to Warrenton.
5.	Business Route 15/29	 Remington curb/gutter and road widening.
6.	U.S. 15/29 and Rt. 28 Intersection	Future interchange concept development.
7.	Interstate 66	Extend acceleration lane from Rt. 17 southbound to Interstate 66 eastbound.
8.	U.S. 15/29/17	Accelerate planning process for the eventual six-laning & interchanges north of Warrenton Spur to the Prince William County line.
9.	U.S. 15/29	Spot safety & intersection improvements, including turn lanes and median closures.


	Primary Road & Priority	Improvements
1.	Interchange @ U.S. 29/U.S. 15-29, South of Warrenton	Full interchange, with access ramps and bridge Rt. 15/17/29; access ramp to Lord Fairfax Community College.
2.	Route 211 – Route 17 Bypass Connector	Major collector connecting Rt. 211 with Rt. 17; portion of the ro-w is reserved from Rt. 211 across to the Town recreation facility and south of Bear Wallow Road.





